Thank You for your recent inquiry concerning our teenage driver education program. TRI COUNTY DRIVING SCHOOL INC. is state approved for driver education training. Also TRI COUNTY DRIVING SCHOOL INC. is a member of the BETTER BUSINESS BUREAU. Our instructors are all licensed driving instructors and many have degrees in Driver Education. '

Driving times are available for your teen year-round. If you have already successfully completed the state requirements for the in person classroom (theory) part of the program, you will only need 12 hours of in-car training. The standard behind the wheel program consists of 6 hours of driving and 6 hours of observation. These are the minimum hours needed to meet states requirements. The cost of the program is \$350.00. We also offer additional lessons at \$55.00 an hour.

Where are students picked up?

- **Boundaries for the Fox Cities:** No farther North than JJ, West – Hwy. CB, East – Kaukauna H.S. (Hillcrest Drive and Loderbauer Road), and South-Hwy. 10.
- **Freedom Students:** Picked up/dropped off either at McDonalds (on Hwy. 41/N) or our Appleton office.
- **Neenah Students:** North – Hwy. BB, West – Hwy. 76, East – Lake Winnebago, South - Hwy. G.
- **Kimberly Students:** Picked up/dropped off at either home or Kimberly High School (within boundaries).
- **All Other Students:** Usually picked up/dropped off at our Appleton office location. Call for information.

Cancellation Policy

All Behind the Wheel lessons must be cancelled at least 24 hours before their driving appointment time. Saturday, Sunday and Monday appointments must be cancelled on Friday before our office closes. The student will be charged \$45.00 for each missed lesson that is not cancelled at least 24 hours in advance. (THIS INCLUDES BEING SICK). Fees must be paid before additional lessons will be scheduled.

To register, complete the form and mail, along with a check for \$350.00.

Once we have received your payment, the office needs to verify the information from your classroom provider. You will be required to stop by our office to sign contract. At that time, we will give you the MV3001 form (this form is needed to take the temps test at the DMV).

Note: Kimberly High School Students: Once enrolled in our program, you will receive the MV3001 form from your Drivers Ed teacher. **Our office needs to stamp and sign that form before going to the DMV.**

You can mail or drop off the payment at our Appleton Office (526 W. Wisconsin Ave. Appleton WI 54911). Summer hours are Mon – Fri, 8am to 4pm. Winter hours are Mon-Fri, 9am to 5pm. Payments can be made in cash or check. (Online registration is available for credit card purchases) Make checks payable to Tri County Driving School. For more information, call us at (920) 734-7330.
